

Dear People of God at Faith Lutheran Church,

In the name of Jesus our Savior, grace, mercy and peace be with you in this season of Lent, which is upon us.

My dog Millie is 14.5 years old. Of late she has had some health challenges, which we are working on. Thankfully she has bounced back, mostly. But the reality is very evident to me. Her journey with us is getting closer to her death. While I don't like to torture myself with that realization, I want to be prepared for that transition. Her needs right now have increased some, even though she is still a happy puppy. We still take walks, but the gait is slower.

At the same time, I notice that the sun is rising earlier, and the signs of spring are emerging from the sleeping, winter time. The green of the mini daffodils at the front door of Faith are poking through the soil and a bit of yellow brightness is showing. Spring is on the way. A time of rebirth.

Lent is a time of re-awakening. A time of pondering. What is God up to? Our focus is both penitence and preparation. Lent is a time of realizing the need to repent and change our ways, and be open to God's mercy. And it is also a time of preparation for the newness of life and grace God brings to us. It is a time of renewal and being open to God's leading.

In late January I had the opportunity to meet Pr Cindy Robles, the new pastor at Good Shepherd. We have had a few coffee times to chat about our two congregations. We both know, as you do, that, at this time in the two congregations, is a time to witness God's renewal and call to repentance and rebirth. Along with the Bishop's staff, we are listening and crafting a process for the two congregations to begin conversations on discovering a "mutual vision" of God's invitation to a new horizon, God's new creation. What that looks like exactly is yet to be seen.

The reality that Faith is facing feels like death. However, I firmly believe that resurrection follows. That life doesn't always look the way we think or want it to look. Think of the Easter story. After a three year ministry, Jesus was arrested, tortured, and put to death by capitol punishment. Everything looked lost and dead to his followers.

Then, three days after his death, Jesus was raised to life by God the Father, only that life was different than before. He could pass through locked doors, and he ascended into heaven. He gave his 12 disciples the instructions to wait for the Holy Spirit to come upon them. And everything changed!

There was work to be done, and the gathering of believers and followers did not look like what they had known with the Temple and the synagogues as worship centers. Empowered by the Holy Spirit, the good news of Jesus Christ was being spread through the world, and people believed. New expressions of gathering and worship evolved.

Our Lenten season leads us to the cross and to the empty tomb. Death and resurrection work together for God's love to be known deeply in us. Yes, there is and will be grief. Yet God has made a way. We travel through this time of penitence and preparation, of death and resurrection, of letting go in order to take hold of the life God has for us. And it will be different.

Let this Lenten season begin with our hearts wide open to the realities we face and celebrate God's faithfulness in and through Faith Lutheran Church. And let our faith be open to the new life God has for Faith as we move through these days. New life is poking through the soil, and it will be beautiful.

My encouragement is that you continue to be open to participating in the conversations that Faith will be engaging with Good Shepherd. God is doing new things with us!

In the realm where seasons weave their dance, March arrives, bringing a hopeful chance. Equinox whispers of celestial might, Winter's grip fades, surrendering to light.


